

Is CLINIC Affiliation the Right Fit for Your Organization?



The CLINIC network is made up of over 420 nonprofit organizations across the United States who are currently serving immigrant newcomers in their communities. These agencies continue to work to grow and sustain their immigration legal services.

Applicants for CLINIC affiliation must meet the following criteria:

- ⊗ Be an established 501c3 organization (not an individual).
- Have a demonstrated mission to serve low-income and other vulnerable immigrants.
- Are currently authorized to provide direct legal services to low-income immigrants or are actively planning to offer such services through attorneys or by acquiring DOJ Recognition and Accreditation.
- Understand the responsibility involved in opening a legal services program.

Applicants may be asked to provide the following, along with their application:

- Proof that immigration legal services matches the organization's mission.
- Current, audited financial statements.
- ⊘ A board of directors' resolution approving CLINIC affiliation.
- ⊘ A community partner's letter of recommendation.

Please Note: Any pending DOJ recognition applications must be adjudicated before applying for CLINIC affiliation.
